Snail Trail Block



There are 20 Snail Trail blocks in my design. For each set of cutting instructions, you need to cut them in 4 colours.

As the instructions are in $7/8^{\text{th}}$ $3/16^{\text{th}}$ etc. I went to the closest

inch $1/4$ etc. and trimmed after stitching. Wash and iron all fabrics.

FABRIC REQUIRED

15" by width of Fabric of 4 colours. **Cut.**

As you cut the pieces place into zip lock bags marked A. B. C. D. E.

- A. 4" x WOF. Cross cut into 4" squares and cut once on the diagonal. Cut this in each fabric.
- B. $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut into $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and cut twice on the diagonal to get four triangles.
- C. $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 25". Cross cut into $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and cut once on the diagonal.
- D. $1\frac{1}{4}$ x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ". Cross cut into $1\frac{1}{4}$ squares.
- E. $2\frac{3}{4}$ x $13\frac{3}{4}$ ". Cross cut twice on the diagonal to get 4 triangles

Sewing instructions.

Using the coloured photo above take one of each colour from the bag marked D. Using a $1/4$ seam stitch the 4 pieces together. Press.

Next take one of each colour from the E bag and stitch onto the square matching colours. Press. Square should now measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". Trim if needed.

3rd step. Take one of each colour from the C bag and stitch matching colours, use the photo above as a guide. Press. Square should now measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " trim if needed.

4th Step. Take one of each colour from the B bag and stitch onto square matching colours. Press. Square should now measure $4\frac{3}{4}$ ". Trim if necessary.

Last step. Take one of each colour from the A bag and stitch onto square matching colours. Press. Square should now measure $6\frac{1}{2}$ ". Trim if necessary.

Give the block a final press.

The Snail Trail Blocks can be chained pieced if preferred.

Square in a Square Block



In my design there are 16 Square in a Square blocks and 4 Snail Trail ones, you may choose to make 20 of the Square in a Square blocks.

For these blocks you will need 4 colours, 1 neutral/background fabric and 3 of your colour choice. All blocks measure 6.5" finished.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

A Fabric Neutral/background, cut two strips $2\frac{1}{4}$ x WOF. Cut into $2\frac{1}{4}$ squares and then cross cut on diagonal once, for each block you need 8 Neutral/background pieces. Place in zip lock bag marked Square in a Square **A**.

A. Using a coloured fabric cut one strip $2\frac{1}{4}$ x WOF and cut into $2\frac{1}{4}$ squares and cross cut once on the diagonal. Place in zip lock bag marked Square in a Square **A**.

B. Colour Cut 2 strips $1\frac{1}{2}$ x WOF. Cross cut into $5\frac{1}{2}$ pieces. Cut a 45° from edge long end.



You need 4 pieces for each block = 64 pieces for 16 blocks. Place in zip lock bag marked B.

C. Colour. Cut two strips 4¼ x WOF and cut into 4¼ squares. Cross cut on diagonal twice, you need 4 pieces for each block. = 16 squares. Place into zip lock bags marked **C** Square in a Square.

Sewing Instructions

From Bag **A** Take 4 neutral/background pieces and 4 colour pieces, put one coloured piece to a neutral piece and stitch using a ¼ seam on the long side, repeat for the other 3 pairs. These pieces make the Windmill centre of the block. Press to the darker colour, trim the points and then sew 2 pairs together and press. You now have 2 blocks with 4 pieces. Stitch together to make the windmill and then press. Trim any points.

From Bag **C** take 4 of the coloured triangles and stitch to each side of your piece, press and trim any points.

From Bag **B** take 4 of the long pieces and stitch one to each side of your piece if not sure how look at the diagram. Press and trim any points.

Last step from Bag **A** take 4 of the neutral/background fabric and stitch to the top of each side, press and trim any points. Square in a Square should now measure 6.5"

Make 15 more of this block
